Effective October 1, 2012, House Bill 499 Vehicle Laws – Disposition of Vehicle to Automotive Dismantler and Recycler or Scrap Processor creates a new process for disposal of motor vehicles without a certificate of title or a salvage certificate. If a vehicle is going to be used for parts only or scrapped and never re-titled, a licensed Automotive Dismantler and Recycler or Scrap Processor (AD&R/SP) can take the vehicle, provide notice (if required), hold the vehicle for 11 business days and then junk/scrap the vehicle. The AD&R/SP must keep detailed records of the transaction including recording the Driver's License and Registration of the person transferring the vehicle, inputting the information into the Maryland State Police's database, and signing the appropriate affidavit form developed by the MVA.

It is important to note the new affidavits are <u>not</u> ownership documents and cannot be used to transfer title. The person providing the vehicle to the AD&R/SP must complete an affidavit and provide any documentation as specified on the form. In addition, if the vehicle is transported by a tow vehicle, a copy of the tow vehicle registration must also be included.

AFFIDAVIT OF OWNERSHIP FOR TRANSFER OF A VEHICLE TO AN AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER OR SCRAP PROCESSOR

Purpose:

Use this form for a vehicle owner, or an agent of a vehicle owner, to certify, under oath, that a Certificate of Title is unavailable for a vehicle that is being transferred to an Automotive Dismantler and Recycler or Scrap Processor for purposes of dismantling, destroying or scrapping, and that the owner shown below is the current owner of the vehicle in the records of the MVA.

Instructions:

Complete form in its entirety. This form must be maintained at the place of business and made available upon request to the MVA or Law Enforcement Officials for a period of at least 3 years. MUST ATTACH:

- 1. A COPY OF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE(S) OF THE OWNER(S) AND A COPY OF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE OF THE AGENT PROVIDING THE VEHICLE (if applicable); AND
- 2. A COPY OF THE VEHICLE'S REGISTRATION CARD OR A COPY OF THE VEHICLE RECORD FROM MVA.

Limitations:

A vehicle may <u>not</u> be retitled or assigned using this document; it may only be dismantled, destroyed or scrapped. For jointly titled vehicles, this form may only be used with consent of, and documentation from, all owners.

AFFIDAVIT OF LAWFUL POSSESSION FOR TRANSFER OF A VEHICLE TO AN AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER OR SCRAP PROCESSOR

Purpose: Use this form to certify, under oath, that a Certificate of Title is unavailable for a vehicle that is being

transferred to an Automotive Dismantler and Recycler or Scrap Processor for purposes of dismantling, destroying or scrapping, and that proper notification has been made pursuant to Maryland law.

Instructions: Complete form in its entirety. This form must be maintained at the place of business and made available

upon request to the MVA or Law Enforcement Officials for a period of at least 3 years. MUST ATTACH:

1. A COPY OF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE OF THE PERSON PROVIDING THE VEHICLE;

. A COPY OF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE OF THE PERSON PROVIDING THE VEHICLE AND

BEFORE THE VEHICLE CAN BE DISMANTLED, DESTROYED OR SCRAPPED, COPIES OF VEHICLE OWNER AND LIEN HOLDER NOTIFICATIONS.

Limitations: A vehicle may <u>not</u> be retitled or assigned using this document; it may only be dismantled, destroyed or scrapped. This form cannot be used for a vehicle towed from a residential or commercial property under a

continuing contract to tow unauthorized vehicles.

FACT SHEET

<u>AFFIDAVIT OF OWNERSHIP</u> FOR TRANSFER OF A VEHICLE TO AN AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER OR SCRAP PROCESSOR (AD&R/SP)

- This affidavit should be completed when the AD&R/SP is receiving the vehicle from the owner/coowner, or the owner's agent, and the Certificate of Title is unavailable. For jointly owned vehicles, the consent of all owners is required.
- The Owner Agent Information section must be completed along with the vehicle and owner information. The owner/co-owner signs and dates the Vehicle Information Certification.
- The AD&R/SP completes the last section of the form with their business information and signs the certification stating they have complied with all applicable Federal and State laws.
- Attach required MVA documentation of vehicle owner identification.
- Note: A vehicle may NOT be re-titled or assigned using this document. It may only be dismantled, destroyed, or scrapped.
- The Indemnity Agreement (CS-081) is now obsolete.
- Information <u>MUST</u> be entered into the Maryland State Police Regional Automated Property Information Database (RAPID) and the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS).

<u>AFFIDAVIT OF LAWFUL POSSESSION</u> FOR TRANSFER OF A VEHICLE TO AN AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER OR SCRAP PROCESSOR (AD&R/SP)

- This affidavit should be completed when the AD&R/SP receives the vehicle from someone other than the owner/co-owner, or agent of the owner.
- The Provider's Information must be completed and include the vehicle and owner/co-owner information. The person providing the vehicle signs and dates the Vehicle Information Certification.
- Notice of intent to dispose of the vehicle must be given to the vehicle owner and any secured party.
- The person making the required notifications must also complete the Notification Certification stating that notice of intent to dispose of the vehicle was given to the vehicle owner and any secured party.
- The AD&R/SP completes the last section of the form with their business information and signs the certification stating they have complied with all applicable Federal and State laws.
- Note: A vehicle may NOT be re-titled or assigned using this document. It may only be dismantled, destroyed, or scrapped.
- The Indemnity Agreement (CS-081) is now obsolete.
- Information <u>MUST</u> be entered into the Maryland State Police Regional Automated Property Information Database (RAPID) and the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS).
